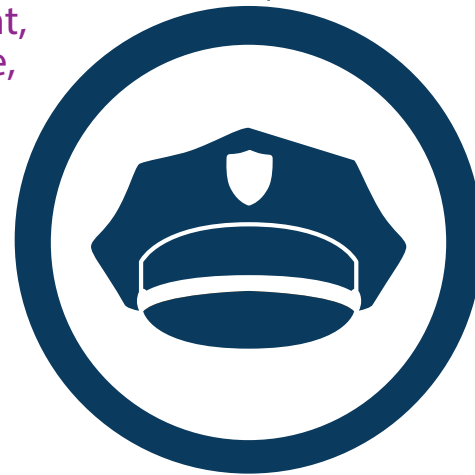


Provide training, and support throughout Wisconsin to include law enforcement, hospital, military, prison, marketplace, hospice, nursing home, and community chaplains.

Provide on-call confidential crisis support to referred victims to include comfort, counseling, education, transportation, and short-term crisis care.

Provide emotional, physical, and spiritual comfort and support through on-site, volunteer, 24/7 crisis response care, counseling, prayer, education, officiating, and awareness.

Develop a licensed chaplain network which can be mobilized quickly and efficiently in a crisis to provide on-site support during accidents, deaths, crimes, domestic violence, natural disasters and other crisis situations.



Build a neutral, non-affiliated, collaborative crisis response care center to provide chaplain services in a confidential, non-threatening, faith-based environment to staff and victims referred by communities, government, law enforcement, community resource agencies, and faith communities.
